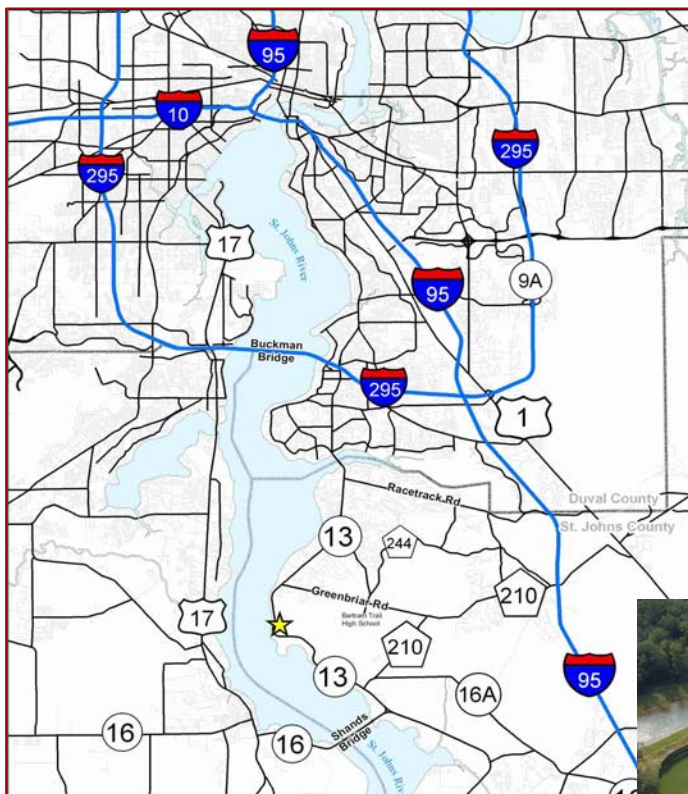
RiverTown Baseball Grounds

Map & Directions

From the NorthWest:

- From I-295 and State Road 13... (SR 13 is San Jose Blvd. at the I-295 interchange).
- Travel South on SR 13 (San Jose Blvd.).
- Turn Left (East) on Swamp Oak Trail approximately 1.6 miles South of Greenbriar Road.

We Welcome you to RiverTown Baseball Grounds... one of the newest and finest facilities in Florida to play baseball – Home of Creeks Baseball Club.



From the North/SouthEast:

- From the interchange of I-95 and State Road 210...
- Travel West on S.R. 210.
- Stay westbound onto Greenbriar Rd where S.R. 210 turns to the South.
- Turn South on SR 13.
- Travel approximately 1.6 miles South on SR 13.
- Turn Left (East) onto Swamp Oak Trail into Park.

From the SouthWest:

- Cross the Shands Bridge to State Road 13...
- Travel North on SR 13.
- Turn Right (East) on to Swamp Oak Trail approximately 4.5 miles North of 16A / 210.



Being new, the current entrance to the Park is a bit inconspicuous, so watch your mileage closely from the map, directions and landmarks. There is no particular signage currently, and a metal, bar-type gate is present at the entrance but should be open for scheduled games or tournaments.
